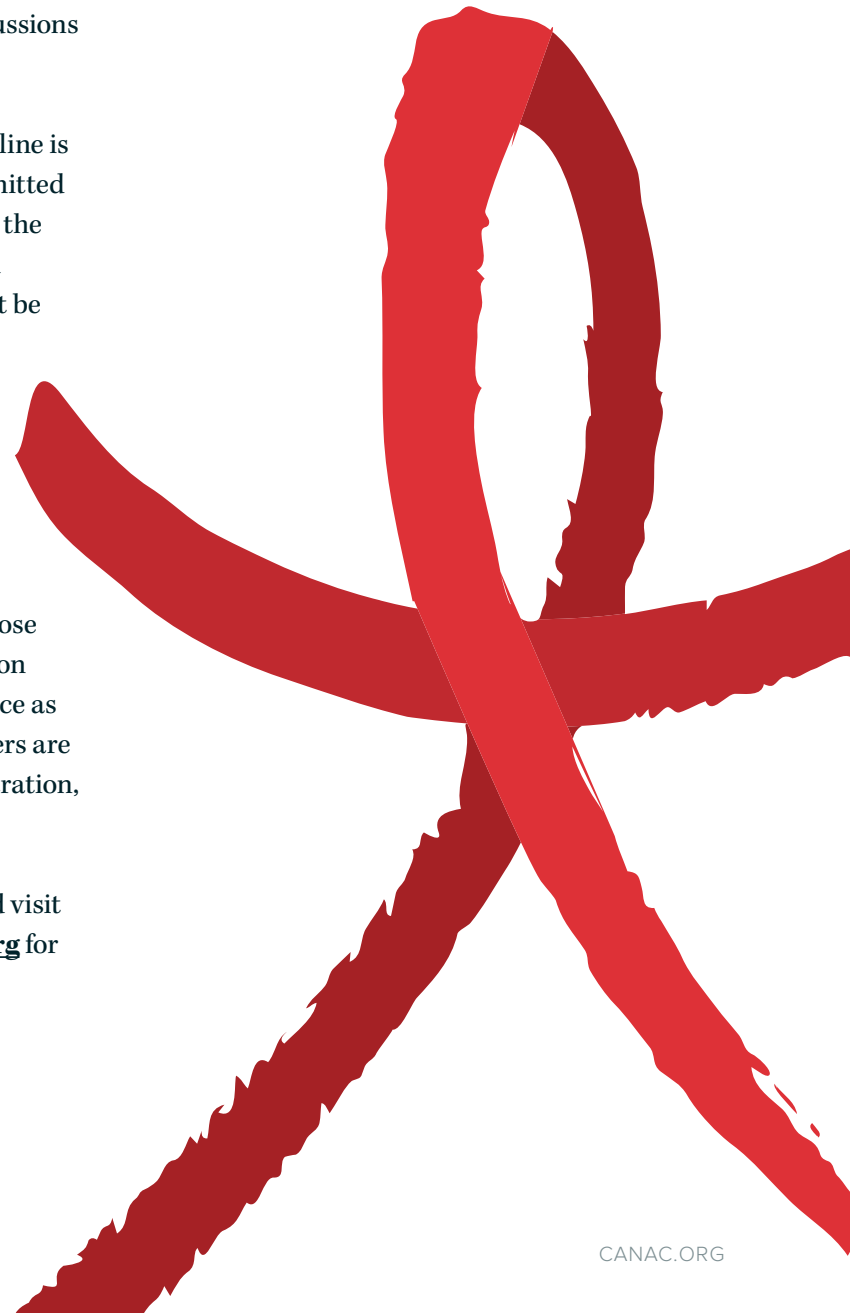
The Conference Planning Committee invites abstracts or workshop outlines in all these areas. Nurses, allied Health Professionals and researchers are welcome to submit abstracts with a particular focus on health interventions, new or ongoing projects in the field of LGBT, HIV/AIDS, nursing research, policy analysis, ethical and legal issues, case studies, literature reviews addressing issues related to LGBT, Transgender health, HIV/AIDS and other interesting topics that would enhance the scope and depth of the discussions we hope to initiate over the course of the conference. We also encourage community-based workers, researchers and academics to submit abstracts/workshop outlines and take part in the conference.

Do you have an idea for a workshop? A workshop consists of a 1.5 hour breakout session. You would have the entire time slot to present your issue in depth. This might include an educational tool or curriculum or maybe a topic where you'd like to engage the audience in more involved discussions or feedback.

The abstract or workshop submission deadline is December 31st 2015. Abstracts can be submitted in either English or French, however due to the high costs of on-site conference translation and low user uptake, all presentations must be conducted in English.

Notification concerning the acceptance of abstracts/workshops will be provided to the corresponding author by February 26, 2016. Confirmation of intention to present by one or more of the authors will be requested prior to March 11, 2015. All those who have had been accepted for presentation will be required to register for the conference as soon as possible after notification. Presenters are responsible for arranging conference registration, accommodation and travel.

Instructions for Submissions

COVER PAGE

The cover page should contain the title of the abstract/workshop and the names of the authors, including their positions and credentials. Please include the name, address, fax number, phone number and e-mail address for the *corresponding author* who is to be contacted concerning the submission. If it is an abstract, please indicate if it is being submitted for consideration for oral or poster presentation.

ABSTRACT/WORKSHOP

All abstracts/workshop outlines should be limited to 250 words and be typed single spaced on an 8 1/2 x 11 page. Only the title of the abstract/workshop should be included, all other identifying information should appear on the cover page. The abstract/workshop outline should include a clear and concise outline of the objectives and content of the presentation.

SCHEDULE

All oral abstract presentations will be 30 minutes in length, including time for questions. Posters will be available for viewing throughout the conference and poster presentation sessions will be scheduled. All workshops will be 1.5 hours in length.
