Join us at the Double Tree by Hilton in London, Ontario where the Canadian Association of Nurses in HIV/AIDS Care (CANAC) will hold its 27th annual conference. It will be held on April 25-27th, 2019, titled “Tradition + Innovation, Informing Today’s HIV care.” This year’s conference program will focus on informing and updating issues in HIV care today along with a pre-conference day on how London strategized and collaborated in the midst of an unprecedented HIV and Hep C crisis. The program will include presentations on HIV & Aging, Women & HIV, policy development and advocacy.

The Conference Planning Committee invites abstracts focusing on clinical management, treatment challenges, nurse leadership, strategies / initiatives to engage patients in care and coinfection. Nurses, Allied Health Professionals, Researchers, Policy Makers and anyone who supports change in the community are welcome to submit abstracts that align with the theme of the conference. We hope to engage attendees in rich discussion that will allow for ideas to flourish, knowledge to be shared and for new directions to emerge.

The abstract and workshop deadline is **January 30, 2019**. Abstracts can be submitted in either English or French, however due to the high costs of on-site conference translation and low user uptake all presentations must be conducted in English.

Notification concerning the acceptance of abstracts will be provided to the corresponding author by **February 25th, 2019**. Confirmation

of intention to present by one or more authors will be requested prior to **March 11, 2019**. All those who have been accepted for presentation will be required to register for the conference as soon as possible after notification. Presenters are responsible for arranging conference registration, accommodation and travel.

We have a room block at the Double Tree by Hilton, with a discounted nightly room rate of 125.00. Room bookings can be accessed on the CANAC website. The room block will be available for booking until **March 20, 2019**. After this date, the room rate will be significantly higher, so please reserve your room prior to this deadline.

Instructions for Submissions

COVER PAGE

The cover page should contain the title of the abstract/workshop and the names of the authors, including their positions and credentials. Please include the name, address, fax number, phone number and e-mail address for the *corresponding author* who is to be contacted concerning the submission. If it is an abstract, please indicate if it is being submitted for consideration for oral or poster presentation.

ABSTRACT/WORKSHOP

All abstracts/workshop outline should be limited to 250 words and be typed single-spaced on an 8 1/2 x 11 page. Only the title of the abstract/workshop should be included, all other identifying information should appear on the cover page. The abstract/workshop outline should include a clear and concise outline of the objectives and content of the presentation.

SCHEDULE

All oral abstract presentations will be 30 minutes in length, including time for questions. Posters will be available for viewing throughout the conference and poster presentation sessions will be scheduled. All workshops will be 1.5 hours in length.
